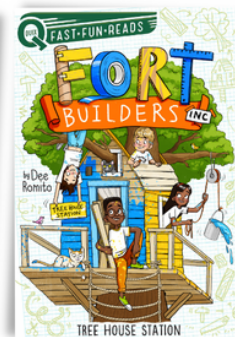
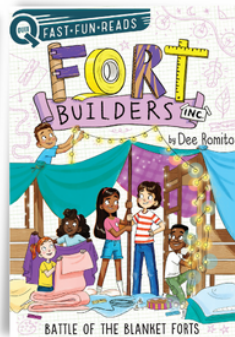
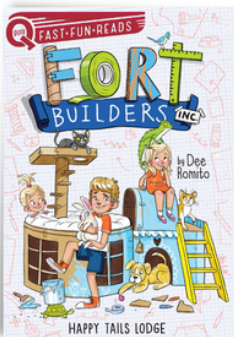
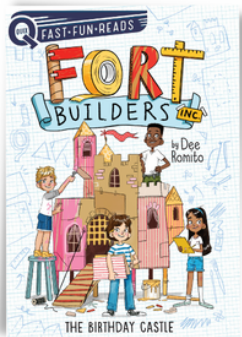


## About Me

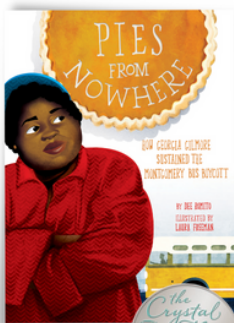

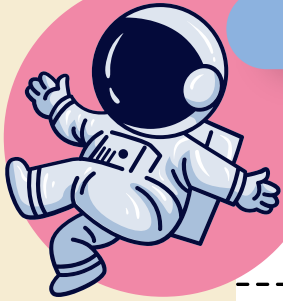


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# Presentation Options

Each presentation can be adjusted for different grade levels.

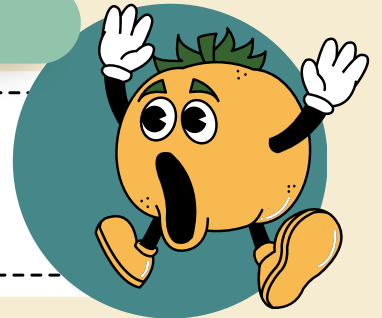


## What a Character!

Every little thing a character does, says, wears, and loves tells us something about him. With the help of a handful of students to assist me, we'll make characters come alive and learn to read and write with a focus on character development.

## But What Goes Wrong?

A story isn't just about all the good things that happen to a character; it's about that character's challenges, rough spots, and obstacles on the journey. We'll talk about plot and how to connect the events in a story using cause & effect.



## Building a Story

Writing a story doesn't start with sitting down to write and it isn't finished after the first draft--It's a Work-in-Progress. I'll share what it takes to get a book published and what the planning, writing, and revision stages look like behind the scenes.



## Revision Magic

Making changes to a story can feel like one of the hardest parts of writing, but it's where the real magic happens. We'll break down the different things to look for during the revision process and learn how to add more details to make it even better.



## Keeping It Real

I'll share how I "keep it real" in both fiction and nonfiction by doing lots of research and mining from real-life experiences. We'll learn how to keep your nonfiction factual and make your fiction more engaging with vivid settings, interesting characters, and fun details.



# AUTHOR VISIT INFO

## What's included?

A full-day visit includes your choice of up to three presentations (30-50 minutes each) in the form of assemblies, classroom workshops, or grade level workshops. Presentations can be repeated for different groups.

An author lunch with students can be included with a full-day visit at no additional cost, if desired. Schools should choose students ahead of time.

## Skype Visits

I offer a limited number of FREE 20-minute Q&A Skype visits to classrooms, after school clubs, girl scout/boy scout troops, and book clubs! Please contact me for more info.

## What does it cost?

My honorarium for the 2023-2024 school year for a full day visit is \$1,000 for local visits. If your school is more than a one-hour drive from the Greater Buffalo area, the fee is \$1,300 plus transportation and lodging fees (if needed). Out of state visits, visits more than a three-hour drive, or visits requiring air transportation are \$1,700 plus transportation, meals, and lodging fees.



Half days are only offered in the Greater Buffalo area and include up to two presentations for \$700. Virtual visits are \$350 per session. Library/Club events are \$350 for one presentation. Afterschool add-ons to author visits are \$350.



## A few things ...

The honorarium is due on the day of my visit.

Teacher guides are available on my website for all of my books.

I'm happy to work with your local independent bookstore to coordinate book sales or connect you with one of my local indies. Books can be signed by me and personalized.

Technology requests: a Smartboard or projector and screen with sound, unless it's a small-group workshop. For groups larger than 1-2 classrooms, a microphone is appreciated.
